### 1. USA, Canada - Tokyo (Japan)

Meet your Tour Director at the airport Japan Airline Group check in counter as you board your flight bound for Japan.

### 2. Tokyo/Narita (D)

Cross the International Date Line. Arrive Japan (Narita) and check in hotel. Enjoy your dinner at hotel. Overnight at Narita Tokyu Hotel or similar.

### 3. Asakusa Kannon Temple – Imperial Palace – Ginza – Fuji TV - Rainbow Bridge – Disney Store (or Tokyo Disney Sea) (B,D)

After breakfast, we will visit Imperial Palace, Asakusa Kannon Temple with its Nakamise shopping arcade for your shopping fun. Next to Imperial Palace, Ginza and Fuji TV to understand the famous TV program production. After lunch, transfer to Rainbow Bridge, the popular entertainment area and Disney Store (For those who don't join Tokyo Tour are welcomed to visit the brand new Tokyo Disney Sea Theme Park at their own entrance cost. Tokyo Disney Sea Them Park stands next to Tokyo Disney Land with numerous exciting entertainments). Overnight at Metropolitan Holiday Inn or similar.

### 4. Edo Era Museum – Hakone Peace Park – Owakudani Spa Valley – Mt. Fuji Kawaguchiko (B,L,D)

After breakfast, we will visit Museum of Edo Era to explore the life style of Edo Era 400 years ago. Lunch at local restaurant. After that, transfer to Izu National Park to visit the Peace Park in traditional Japanese landscape. Transfer to Owakudani Spa Valley to view the famous hot spring. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at Kawaguchiko Koryu Hotel or similar.

### 5. Lake Hamana – Lake Irigo - Ise Temple – Ise Toba (B,L,D)

After breakfast, we passing through the Lake Hamana where is famous for eel farming. Take a cruise at Lake Irigo. Arrive Ise Temple with more than 1000 years history to visit the Naiku and Geku where combined with 125 shrine. Late afternoon, we arrive the largest tourist city in

Shima district - Ise Toba. She is lying beside the beautiful Toba Bay with many sightseeing facilities for you to enjoy. Overnight at Ise Seaside Hotel or similar.

### 6. Ise Toba – Jofuku Park – Nachi Falls - Pagoda of Kumano Shrine (B,L,D)

After breakfast, we visit Jofuku Park where to memorial Jofuku who leaded 3000 boys and girls from China to Japan to search the forever life medication for Emperor Qin 2000 year ago. After that, we arrive the No. 1 waterfall in Japan – Nachi Falls with water flow in 1 ton/second. Enjoy this great waterfall from Pagoda of Kumano Shrine where a thousand hands Quanyin stature was erect. Check in to Hot Spring hotel after dinner. Overnight at Resort Royal Hotel or similar.

### 7. Sandan Heki Hashigu Iwa – Senjyo Jiki – Doujyoji Temple - Shinsaibashi (B,L,D)

Transfer to Sandan Heki Hashigu Iwa to view the grand cliff facing Pacific Ocean after breakfast. Next to Senjyo Jiki to see the beautiful sedimentary rock corroded by Pacific Ocean years after years, followed by visiting Doujyoji temple where was the background of famous Japanese opera. Final stop at Shinshibashi, the longest shopping arcade in Osaka. Overnight at Osaka Granvia Hotel or similar.

### 8. Osaka – Hong Kong (B)

After breakfast at hotel, join your flights this morning bound for Hong Kong. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. The rest of the day is free at leisure. Overnight at Kowloon Hotel or Prudential Hotel

### 9. Hong Kong

### 10. Hong Kong - USA/Canada

Today free at your leisure, then transfer to International Airport at your own arrangement for returning to US/Canada cities. (Extended stay in Hong Kong is available at your own expenses).
